


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Reliable Promising – Creating a System of Accountability

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Making Reliable Promises

accountable when. be can

- I have the ability to say no
- I am competent to perform or have access to competent people
- I estimate and plan how long it will take
- I have the capacity and I'll allocate it
- I'm not having a private unspoken conversation with myself
- I'm not hoping someone else will break their promise first, letting me off the hook
- I will be responsible for success or failure of delivery
